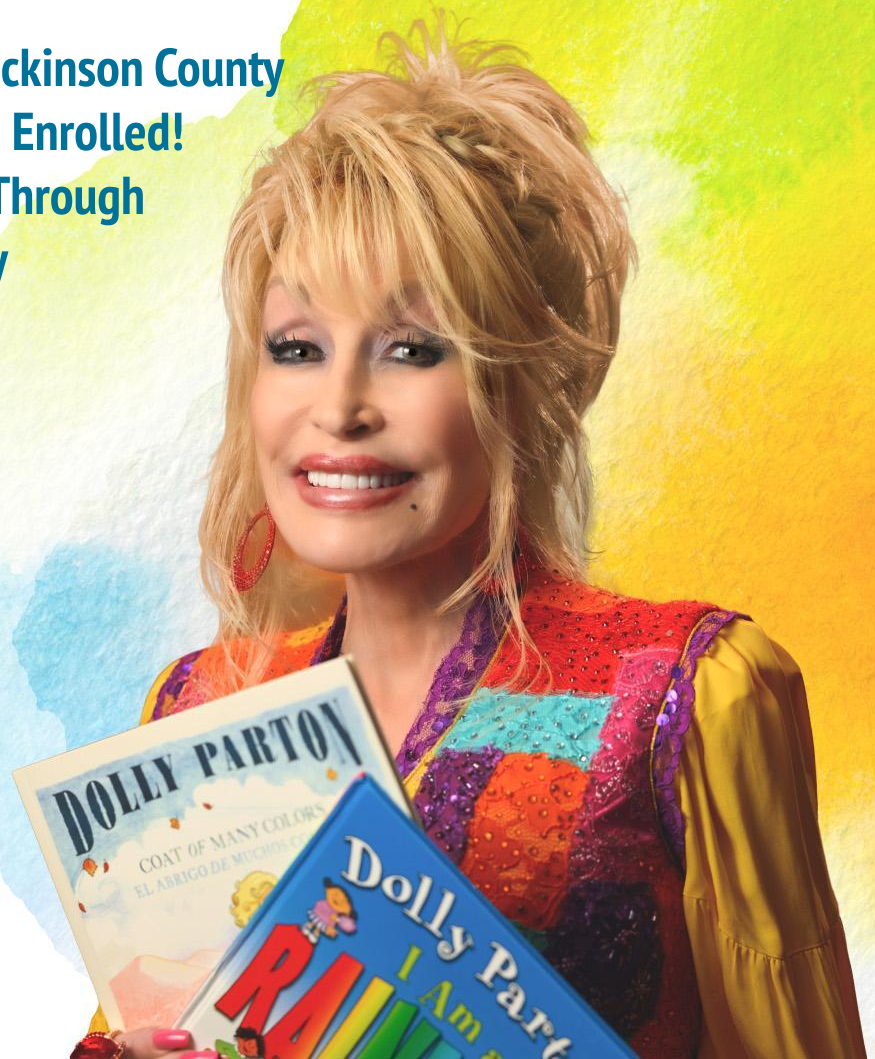

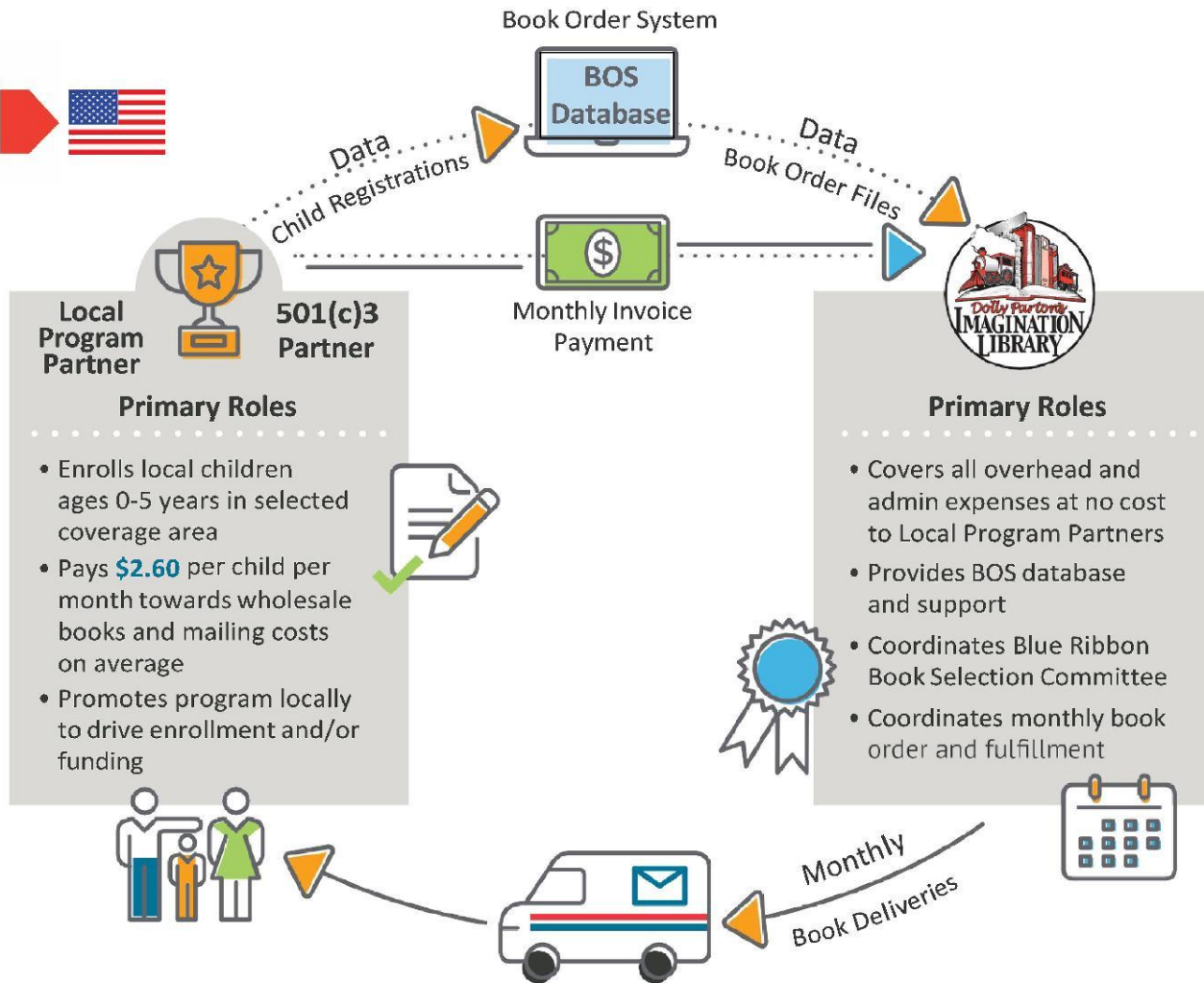

In 1995, inspired by her father's inability to read or write, Dolly Parton launches the Imagination Library to foster an early love of reading and learning in her hometown in Sevier Co., TN. Since then, it has become the highest quality, most impactful, instantly recognized book gifting resource that policy makers, funders, early childhood organizations and families trust **to inspire a love of reading.**

Imagination Library operates in 5 countries: United States, Canada, United Kingdom, Australia and Republic of Ireland.
